Job Summary: Under the direct supervision of the Construction Manager this position is responsible for reading blue prints, determining what materials are required, gathering price comparisons and preparing bids based on the information collected for the Blue Earth Federal Corporation construction projects.

- 2 year Associate's degree in construction cost estimating, or other applicable program; (Preference will be given to applicants with a Bachelor's degree) OR a minimum of 5 years demonstrated career experience.
